A new chapter is being written for Monte-Carlo Beach following the arrival of Stéphane Valeri as head of Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer. The hotel is undergoing a revitalization that began in 2024 with the arrival of René Blino, and which will unfold in successive waves throughout the 2025 season and continue through to 2027.



René Blino joined Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer in January 2024, succeeding Danièle Garcelon as head of Monte-Carlo Beach. She passed the torch at the end of a long and distinguished career.


René Blino has made his mark in the world of luxury and niche hospitality, from Bangkok to Paris, via Cannes, Kuala Lumpur, and Courchevel. He most recently came from Paris, where he had been managing the Hotel Madame Rêve since its opening in 2021, a property particularly acclaimed for its two-starred dining.

Well-versed in the new expectations of an ultra-luxury clientele, René Blino now takes on the challenge of not only upholding but further developing the legend of this iconic hotel, born in 1929. With experience in roles ranging from Director of Human Resources, Director of Rooms, Director of Food & Beverage, and Hotel Manager at prestigious international establishments, René Blino brings a 360-degree understanding of luxury hospitality. Backed by this rich background, he now leads Monte-Carlo Beach.



The Spirit of a « Social Club » Between Sea and Pine Forest

Monte-Carlo Beach embodies a timeless yet contemporary art of living: a villa set on the sea, ideal for breathing, slowing down, and enjoying life in a protected, inspiring setting. Connected to the vibrant heart of Monaco yet sheltered from the world's hustle and bustle, Monte-Carlo Beach offers guests an intimate and elegant retreat, deeply rooted in nature with breathtaking views of the Mediterranean. A soothing experience in perfect harmony with its environment, this sunny summer destination invites rest, activity, and rejuvenation. This little paradise between sky and sea is welcoming to all: La Vigie Point and its beautiful pine forest overlooking the beach are designated an LPO (Bird Protection League) sanctuary.



Monte-Carlo Beach is also the result of a mythical history that defines its soul: a dream born in the Roaring Twenties, of a palace “with its feet in the water,” built around an Olympic-sized swimming pool. Its luxurious services and legendary summer parties would define its fame throughout the 20th century. At its inception, the hostess of the venue was the famous American journalist Elsa Maxwell, a leading figure of the high-society scene of the era, and the namesake of the hotel's Michelin-starred restaurant: Elsa.

In 1928, the opening of Monte-Carlo Beach was marked by a memorable launch party. The event was covered in every social column, establishing the hotel as the new meeting place for the artistic, musical, and cultural elite. In 1929, the final construction was completed by Roger Séassal. The hotel was designed in the style of Californian villas, with a pure Art Deco aesthetic.



The curved geometry of Monte-Carlo Beach follows the coastline, nestled in the shade of the pine forest. The refined simplicity of its lines gives the hotel its charm—discreet, elegant luxury.

In addition to its hotel and dining offerings, Monte-Carlo Beach functions as a private club: social, seaside, and athletic. This spirit is reinforced this season with wellness offerings (group classes and on-demand sessions), the creation of two padel courts, renovation of the fitness room and changing rooms, and a lively program of activities (Easter weekend, inter-member padel tournament, parent-child yoga sessions, and more).

A Michelin Star for Elsa Chef Marcel Ravon's Seaside Garden



Tucked away in the intimacy of Monte-Carlo Beach, the restaurant Elsa is a true jewel on the Riviera. Its elegant ambiance, inspired by 1930s chic, offers a Mediterranean art de vivre escape. The dining room evokes an underwater world, where azure tones subtly mirror the curves of the coastline. A setting bathed in blue and light, ideal for a timeless lunch or dinner. The expansive terrace, with the sea as the only horizon, invites guests to a captivating sensory experience, gently lulled by the sound of the waves and the caress of the sea breeze.

Elsa was awarded a Michelin star by the Michelin Guide France 2025, marking a significant milestone for Chef Marcel Ravin, Chef Domenico D'Antonio, who was entrusted with leading Elsa's kitchen, and the entire Monte-Carlo Beach team—just one year after Chef Ravin began developing a bold “marine garden” concept at the restaurant.

Hailing from his native Martinique, Chef Marcel Ravin, now with three Michelin stars to his name (two stars at Blue Bay Marcel Ravin and one at Elsa), brings with him a deep respect for the sea and maritime culture. He chose to celebrate this heritage through Elsa's menu by creating a true marine garden—where the treasures of the sea are harmoniously combined with the bounty of the land. Bold pairings create a delightful symphony of flavors, showcasing the richness of the marine environment. Here, seawater steaming; there, a marine and plant-based broth. Each seafood element is used to elevate land-based ingredients in a dining experience that is both ethical and flavorful.

The establishment signed, for the second consecutive year on March 21, 2025, the Mister Goodfish charter, which promotes more sustainable consumption of seafood by focusing on species and seasonality, helping to prevent overfishing. Elsa was also honored in 2023 with the “Ethical and Environmental Responsibility Award” by La Liste, reflecting its commitment to culinary excellence driven by a sustainable vision of fine dining.

Located on the cape at Monte-Carlo Beach and nestled in a lush private park, Villa La Vigie boasts breathtaking panoramic views of the Mediterranean, the Principality, and the Bay of Roquebrune-Cap-Martin.



Spanning approximately 600 m² over three levels, the villa offers 6 bedrooms, 4 bathrooms, 1 shower room, 2 walk-in closets, 2 offices, and a refined, understated decor. A magnificent 237 m² terrace, along with marble, columns, fireplaces, parquet floors, and high ceilings, creates a modern, sophisticated ambiance. Several luxury hotels in the South of France are next on her list.

For Monte-Carlo Beach, Dorothée Delaye has redesigned the outdoor furnishings of Le Deck to foster convivial dining, and the Olympic pool surroundings to create spaces of timeless relaxation. The full PAOMA line is made in France, COSMEBIO-labeled, and COSMOS Organic-certified by ECOCERT, with 99–100% natural ingredients.



Padel at Monte-Carlo Beach Hôtel

Derived from tennis and squash, padel has experienced rapid growth in recent years. Fun and accessible regardless of age or skill level, it is played by four players, making it a particularly social and convivial sport. Padel perfectly embodies the spirit of Monte-Carlo Beach as a seaside social club.

A strong environmental commitment



Monte-Carlo Beach has been Green Globe certified since 2014, an internationally recognised certification designed for the luxury travel and tourism industry. In 2023, the property achieved Platinum status, the highest level of the programme, rewarding over ten years of continuous certification. Within this framework, the hotel implements an action plan aligned with the commitments set out in the 4th Sustainable Development Charter of the S.B.M. Group.

Among the initiatives undertaken, in terms of responsible purchasing, guest rooms feature welcome amenities from an organic skincare line made with Corsican maquis plants. The hotel also uses eco-labelled cleaning and laundry products, serves organic and fair-trade coffee, and operates French-made, eco-designed and recyclable coffee machines.

The hotel is also committed to energy efficiency. Beyond promoting eco-friendly habits, the property now purchases the equivalent of its total electricity consumption in renewable energy.

In terms of waste management, all recyclable waste is subject to systematic sorting. In bathrooms, partially used soaps are recycled by the SapCycle association, which redistributes them free of charge to families in need. Organic kitchen waste is dehydrated and processed through a specialised recovery channel.

To combat food waste, Monte-Carlo Beach joined the initiative “Monaco Takes Action Against Food Waste” in 2017, launched by the City of Monaco and the MC2D association. The “My Gourmet Box” has been introduced in the restaurants, allowing guests to take away uneaten dishes.

Committed to responsible gastronomy, the restaurants Elsa, Maona and Le Deck are members of the Mr.Goodfish programme, which promotes seafood diversity and helps protect species affected by overconsumption.

In 2022, Monte-Carlo Beach was awarded the “Green” Special Prize at the Hôtel & Lodge Awards, presented by France’s leading tourism magazine Hotel & Lodge. This distinction recognises the editorial teams’ and tourism professionals’ favourite hotel for its strong commitment to eco-responsibility and sustainable development.

Closely connected to its natural environment, Monte-Carlo Beach is strongly committed to preserving local biodiversity.

In 2021, a positive-biodiversity reef breakwater was created as part of the hotel beach renovation works. Located 100 metres offshore, this underwater structure was designed to protect the beach while encouraging the development of marine life. The newly created area resembles a lagoon, with a sandy seabed bordered by Posidonia seagrass meadows and rocks, offering swimmers an exceptional natural observation area while respecting marine ecosystems.

In October 2022, an environmental impact assessment conducted by an independent consultancy confirmed the stabilisation of Posidonia, as well as rich marine life, with 22 different fish species recorded near the breakwater, including two protected species listed on the European Red List of threatened species: the brown grouper and the corb. The observed increase in black sea urchins is a sign of the vitality of this natural refuge.



The La Vigie Headland and its magnificent pine forest overlooking the beach have been classified as an LPO Bird Refuge (French League for the Protection of Birds) since 2019, making Monte-Carlo Beach a key sanctuary for local biodiversity. Several nesting boxes have been installed to welcome both nesting and protected bird species.

In 2023, the LPO refuge area was expanded fourfold, creating a vast natural nesting area of nearly 20,000 m². Educational trails are offered to children for a playful discovery of the site's natural richness, while adults can enjoy guided tours led by a naturalist around the property.

Green spaces are managed according to a "Zero Phyto" approach, favouring biological pest control, supported by specific training for gardeners and monitoring by the Group's Environmental Department experts.

In terms of soft mobility, Monte-Carlo Beach operates electric vehicles and has introduced a 100% electric inter-hotel shuttle service. Free electric charging stations are also available in the hotel car park. The property supports sustainable mobility in the Principality through the installation of a MonaBike electric bike station located on the hotel grounds. Since 2025, six high-end bicycles have been available to guests, including four adult bikes and two balance bikes to help younger children learn to ride.

Finally, the property actively communicates its commitments and initiatives to all stakeholders. Guests are informed and encouraged through the display of the 4th Sustainable Development Charter and the availability of in-room information leaflets. Employees benefit from training initiatives and ongoing awareness-raising through internal tools such as forums, e-newsletters and an internal blog. Partners are provided with an ethical charter to be respected.



Awards & Distinctions

Monte-Carlo Beach joined the Relais & Châteaux collection in 2009, recognizing the core values and high standards shared by all Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer hotels.

It was awarded its fifth star in 2010, meeting the highest international hospitality standards.

Numerous awards have acknowledged Monte-Carlo Société des Bains de Mer's commitment to guests and its vision of responsible, authentic luxury at Monte-Carlo Beach:
